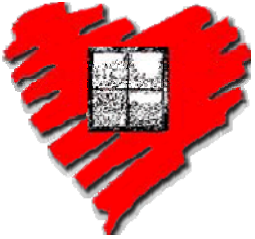

### **Keynote Speakers: Influencing Public Policy: National and State Perspectives**

**Jim Walsh** is the Director of Education and Public Policy for Family Promise, a national network of 124 affiliates, which collectively mobilize over 110,000 volunteers from some 4,500 congregations of all faiths to provide nearly 20,000 individuals each year with shelter, support, meals...and hope for the future.

**F. Scott McCown** retired as a state district judge in 2002 to become executive director of the Center for Public Policy Priorities, an independent, non-partisan, nonprofit policy research organization committed to improving public policies and private practices to better the economic and social conditions for low and moderate-income Texans. Called "the voice of the voiceless" and "the conscience" of Texas politics by Texas Monthly, he is responsible for the center's direction and administration.
